

RICHARD KENT THOMPSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND / TUITION ASSISTANCE

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLY FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Richard Kent Thompson Scholarship Fund (the “Fund”) provides limited financial assistance in the form of tuition assistance for the Mining and Land Resource Institute (“MALRI”) held annually in March in Reno, Nevada, to individuals currently enrolled in an accredited college or university, or to those currently working in the minerals industry that face financial constraints due to unemployment or under-employment (i.e., working significantly fewer billable hours in the last twelve calendar months than the previous twelve calendar months), who would like to attend various educational events relating to the minerals industry throughout the year.

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and make award recommendations to the Board of Directors based on the information provided by the applicant. It is the applicant’s responsibility to timely submit all of the required information noted below. No payment will be made on behalf of the applicant until all required information has been timely received by the committee and the Board of Directors has approved the application. The applications will be kept confidential. Details on MALRI can be found on the American Association of Professional Landmen’s website landman.org or the Nevada Landmen’s Association’s website nvlandman.org.

To receive assistance, you must submit a written request for tuition assistance that includes all of the following information:

- Registration flyer from the MALRI event for which you are requesting tuition assistance with a brief description of the date, location and registration cost of the event
- A brief paragraph discussing who you are
- Provide an explanation as to how you believe this event will benefit your goals in the mineral industry
- The reason tuition assistance is needed
- Your current education or employment status
- A brief statement of what being a Landman means to you
- Previous programs for which tuition assistance was provided by The Fund, if any
- Please provide information on any academic or professional affiliations to which you are a member that relate to this event and/or the minerals industry.

Your requests must be received at least 30 days prior to the event. Please complete the application in English and make sure all information is neatly printed or typed. Also, please sign and date all applications.
